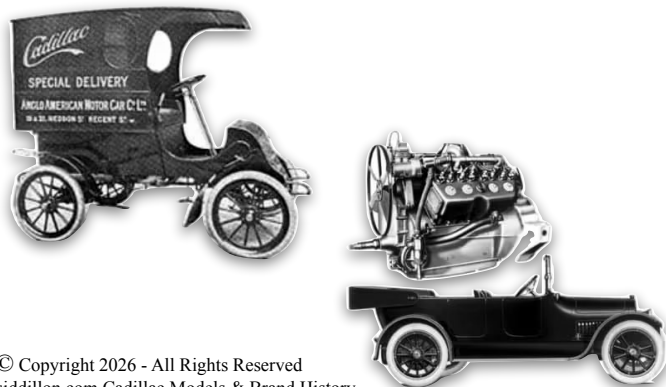

The Iconic Runabout and Tonneau

Cadillac's debut models, the Runabout and Tonneau, were introduced at the 1903 New York Auto Show, garnering attention with their 10-horsepower single-cylinder engine. Over 2,000 orders flooded in, establishing Cadillac as a formidable player in the automotive world.

These models were more than just cars—they were a testament to Cadillac's emphasis on quality and precision engineering, foreshadowing the brand's continuous path of innovation and automotive excellence. In 1909, Cadillac became part of General Motors (GM), solidifying its status as GM's premier luxury brand.

Cadillac introduced the world's first mass-produced V8 engine in 1915, delivering 70 horsepower, a top speed of 65 mph, and setting the standard for performance engines.

The Kickoff Luncheon was a great success!!! Attendance was good and as usual, Billy's Stone Crab didn't disappoint.

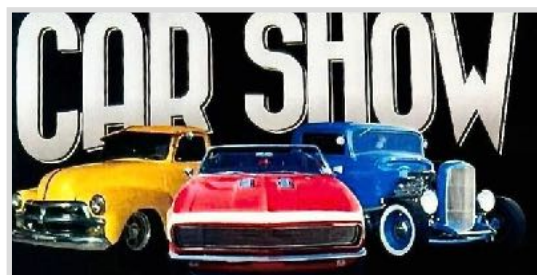
A Spring Picnic will be planned probably for some time in April when we can be sure that it won't be too cold or too hot.

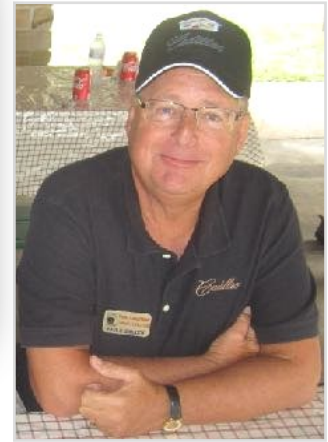
A good Time Had By All...

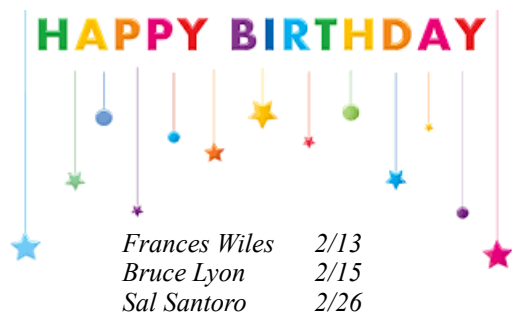

The Historical Evolution of VIN Numbers



Vehicle Identification Numbers (VINs) originated as far back as 1954 as manufacturer-specific, non-standardized codes to help track production. In 1981, the official mandate came out where the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration chartered a 17-character standardized format for all

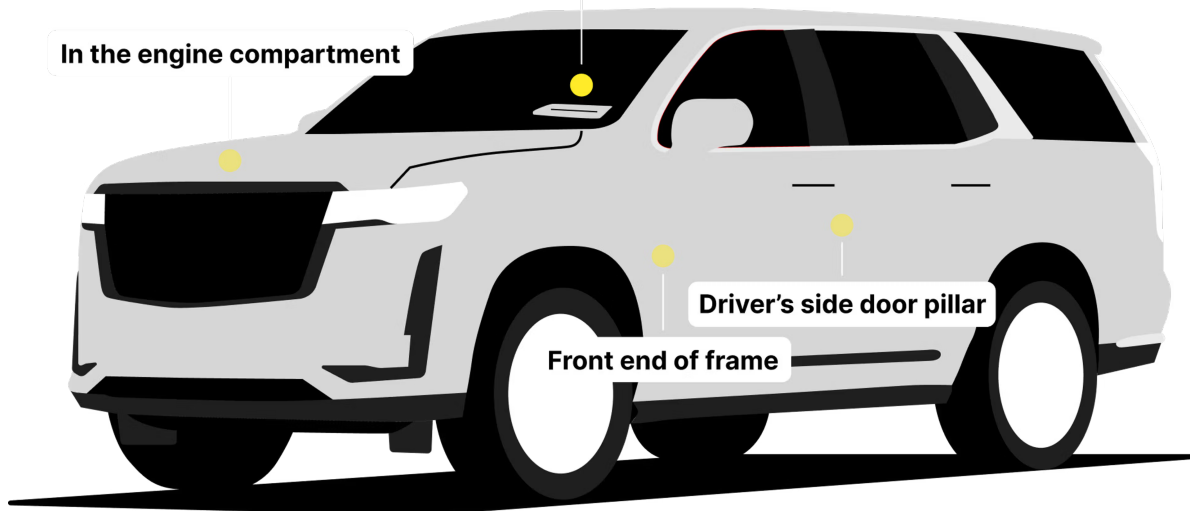
registered vehicles on public roads which facilitated a unique identifier to be assigned to each production vehicle coming off the line. This allowed manufacturers to conduct transportation recall tracking protocols and to promote theft deterrence.
